- Complete and/or reconnect with their education
- Feel connected with their local community
- Get involved in group-based programs
- Access other community services and support
- Participate in youth-led events

Who can we help?

Young people can self refer or be referred by families, schools, or agency workers.

We support all young people at risk including those under the Guardianship of the Minister, youth in juvenile justice system, and people who are Aboriginal, Torres Strait Islander or Culturally and Linguistically Diverse.
