Our Flexible Learning Options program can help young people get back into learning, training and exploring employment pathways.

How can we help?

We work closely with young people across Adelaide's north and south to offer:

- Case management
- Engagement programs
- Access to education and training courses, including access to computers/internet, kitchen/cooking facilities and horticulture (vineyards, olive grove and gardens)
- Reading and writing skills
- Numeracy learning
- Vocational skill development
- Life skills
- A community learning space
- Access to outreach and advocacy support, and information
- Referral to other services, support and community activities

Who can apply?

Young people under 21, who've been referred by their school or education provider.
