How can we help?

We provide affordable housing to those on low to moderate incomes who are having difficulty securing housing in the private rental market.

We have a range of housing options, from units to free-standing homes, and manage tenancies and properties as a landlord.

Who can we help?

To apply for community housing you must:

- Live in South Australia
- Not own or part-own a home
- Meet income, cash and asset eligibility limits

To view the eligibility limits, visit www.sa.gov.au.

How is rent calculated?

Primarily, we offer two types of housing options: 'Social Housing' and 'Affordable Housing'.

For Social Housing, rent is based on a percentage of household income. Whereas, for Affordable Housing rent is based on a percentage of market rental prices.

Where are our properties located?

While we provide housing across a number of areas in metropolitan Adelaide, most of our housing options are located in the northern and western suburbs.
