Köc pïr ke njäk anöj yic cïtmën de Australians kök agut yic de pïr löjik ku thiekic. Akut de njäk (NDIS) alëu bë köc kony köc pïr kek njäk ku bë njek alöc de deetic ku tek ka be yakony në ka yuïc yic.

Akut de njäk (NDIS) yekunu?

Akut de njäk ee köc pïr kek njäk muöc në loi ku kony kek në ka yuïckë bïk ka yök. Käk alëu bïk këk ke pïr yetök təcïn kony pöcc, ye ya bak de akut de köc ciëj ke yen ku ye yecin mat thïn, gör në luoi ku yoc aduot ku nyitit në kek.

Nöj yen yic në bak de akut ë njäk (NDIS),

Ku bë yïn yiëk ajueer de akut njäk (NDIS), ke ran adhil bë:

- Nöj njäk ci bë jään ku yeke gël eke cie ya bak de ka ye loi akölököl. Kän alëu bë ya njäk de guöp ka njäk de nyïc, ka de rielic de piöc ka tuenytueny ke nom.
- Tö në run ke 65 cök piny në thää ler yen në akut de njäkic (NDIS).
- Tö ke ye ran (Australian) ka nöj bidha ka nöj bidha ye yen gël.
- Ciëj në bai löj tö akut de njäk (NDIS).

Akut de njäk ku akut ekony de köc ci dhiop ku nöj kë njäk aci thöj. Të nöj ran yic ku bë ajueer de akut njäk yök (NDIS) ke aci dhil bë wëu ye gäm yen në akuma yenë ke yen kuony pëen.

Lëu ba acir akut de njäk thiëc kadi?

Të tö runku në kaam dhorou ku 64, ku piëere kekë njäk:

- Yup **1800 800 110**, göc në thää 8am bakic leer 8pm thëei, në Köletök leer Köledhiëc ba lëk juëc në bak de akut köc nöj njäk (NDIS).
- Yïn alëu ba yup aya tënë bëny de baidu (LAC) të leer yïn në wëbthiet de akut de njäk (NDIS) [ndis.gov.au/about-us/locations](https://www.ndis.gov.au/about-us/locations).

Akut de baidu (LAC) abë yïn kony në göör de akut kony yen puoth kek yïn ku kuony në baidu. Kän tekdö yenee kony töj yen yuïc. Të yuïc yïn kuonydö, ke akut de baidu (LAC) ke abë yïn kony në de ajueer de akut e njäk (NDIS)

Të nöj yïn meth në kaam këläaric ku run ke dhetem pïr kek njäk ka gäu në dïtic:

- Yuöpe **1800 800 110**, në thää 8am bakic leer në 8pm thëei, Köletök leer Köledhiëc ku thiëc akut yen lui kek mïth kor në baidu

Të yuïc yïn bë yïn kony jam në Dïnlith, ke yïn thiëc ran ruäi kek yïn, ran nyintit ka muöth bë yïn kony. yïn alëu ba yup aya në **telepun athook 131 450**.

Të ce yïn piñ ka cie jam, ke yïn yuöpë 1300 555 727 (jam ka piñ) ta thiëc kë 1800 800 110, cëë 1800 555 677 (TTY) ta thiëc kë 1800 800 110.

Akut de (LAC) tö në bai löjdu alëu bi yïn kony në yök de yan ke kony kök, në akutnomdu yic ku cïn wëu ye tääu piny në akut de njäk (NDIS). Ran ekony bë deetic ku beer thiëc təcïn yen rëec në akut de njäk (NDIS) waragak atö tënë akut de njäk ye kony në (08) 8351 9500.

NATIONAL DISABILITY INSURANCE SCHEME (NDIS)

GETTING THE HELP YOU NEED TO LIVE THE LIFE YOU WANT TO LIVE

People living with a disability have the same rights as other Australians including the right to a dignified and meaningful life. Australia's National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) can assist people living with a disability to understand their individual choices and make decisions that best support their needs.

What is the NDIS?

The NDIS provides people living with a disability the services and supports they need to achieve their goals. These may include developing skills for living more independently, taking a more active role in the community, finding a job and purchasing the equipment and care they need.

Am I eligible for the NDIS?

To be eligible for the NDIS, a person must:

- Have a disability that will not go away and which prevents them from taking part in everyday activities. This can be a physical or intellectual disability, as well as a learning disorder or mental health condition.
- Be aged under 65 when they enter the NDIS.
- Be an Australian citizen or holder of a permanent visa or Protected Special Category visa.
- Live in an area where the NDIS is available.

The NDIS and disability support pension are not the same. If a person is eligible for and receives a NDIS Plan it should not affect their approved Centrelink disability support pension payments.

How can I request a NDIS Plan?

If you are aged between seven and 64 years of age, and living with a disability:

- Call **1800 800 110**, from 8am to 8pm, Monday to Friday for more information about the NDIS.
- You can also contact the Local Area Coordinator (LAC) partner office for your local area by visiting the NDIS website: [ndis.gov.au/about-us/locations](https://www.ndis.gov.au/about-us/locations). The LAC will help you to find suitable services and supports in your local area. This might be the only support you need. If you need more support, the LAC will assist you to access a NDIS plan.

If you have a child aged between zero and six living with a disability or developmental delay:

- Call **1800 800 110**, from 8am to 8pm, Monday to Friday and ask for the Early Childhood Early Intervention agency in your local area.

If you need help speaking in English, ask a family member, carer or friend to help you. You can also call the **Telephone Interpreting Service** on **131 450**.

If you have hearing or speech loss, call 1300 555 727 (Speak and Listen) or call 1800 555 677 and ask for 1800 800 110 or 1800 555 677 (TTY).

What if I am not approved to receive a NDIS Plan?

The LAC in your local area can help you to access other services, within your own community and not funded through the NDIS. Advocacy support to understand and appeal a rejected NDIS application is available through the Disability Rights Advocacy Service on (08) 8351 9500.
