NSW COVID-19 OUTBREAK PRECAUTIONS AT UNITINGSA SITES

Dear Contractor/Supplier,

In light of the COVID-19 outbreak in NSW and State Government travel restrictions, UnitingSA has introduced new precautionary measures to ensure the ongoing health and safety of those we support.

As someone who visits UnitingSA sites to carry out work, it is important you are aware of the action we are taking and adhere to the new requirements, as outlined below.

Until further notice:

- Anyone who has been in NSW since 11 December, or in close contact with someone who has, is not permitted to enter a UnitingSA site, including our Residential Aged Care facilities.

In addition, we continue to ask that all Contractors/Suppliers do not visit a UnitingSA site if they:

- are awaiting COVID-19 test results
- have been in contact with a suspected or confirmed COVID-19 case
- are displaying any associated symptoms of COVID-19, including fever, chills, cough, sore throat, runny nose, shortness of breath, or loss of taste or smell.
