



What will it cost?

The Australian Government provides funding for Home Care Packages, but you will be asked to contribute to the cost of your care. The amount you pay will be determined by your income.

If you don't wish to wait for funding approval, or are not entitled to government funding, and want to start receiving services straight away, you have the option of buying services through our self-funded service program.

This could be as a one-off service or a bundle of services. Our self-funded services are flexible and easy to arrange.

How does it work?

We work closely with you to create a package of services that responds to your assessed care needs.

- First, you will need to contact My Aged Care on 1800 200 422 and arrange an assessment by an Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT).
- The ACAT assessment will determine the level of support you can receive.

We understand it can be complex. But there's no need to worry — we're here to guide you through the process.

What will you receive?

- A package of services designed by you and delivered by friendly, familiar staff
- A flexible professional service
- A monthly service statement identifying your budget and services provided
- Experienced advisors supporting you to maintain control of your life
- The option of language and cultural support



Here's a sample of the types of services we provide.

Home help

- Housework, cleaning, laundry, home maintenance and gardening

Nursing and allied health

- Assistance and advice with mobility, medication management, home modifications, continence management, wound care, dementia care, palliative care, and consultation with a Nurse Practitioner

Personal care

- Bathing and dressing, including access to home hairdressing and hospital-at-home support

Equipment

- Mobility, and bathroom or personal aids

Meal preparation

- Cooking and overseeing dietary requirements

Social support

- Outings and excursions, as well as support maintaining family and community links

Shopping

- Assistance to get the things you need

Transport

- Assistance to attend appointments and community activities

Pet care

- Dog walking, cat care and vet appointments

Respite care

- Short-term residential care

Self-funded services

- Fee-for-service is available if ineligible for government funding
