Support is offered to Aboriginal parents/carers and your children to increase learning opportunities. We can help you develop a relationship with your children's school and get you involved in their education by offering:

- Individual support and referrals to other services
- Parent and/or carer sessions
- Early learning sessions for children delivered at preschool or school

Who can we help?

The Connected Families Program helps Aboriginal children between 3 and 12 who are enrolled in Preschools or Primary Schools across the Port Adelaide Enfield council area. Referrals can be made through self-referral, schools or agencies.
