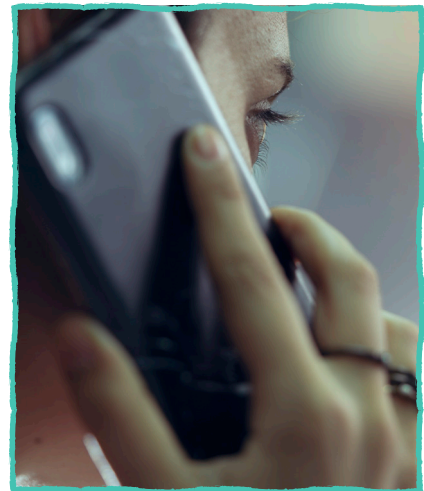


EMERGENCY INFORMATION FOR NDIS PARTICIPANTS

UnitingSA is unable to provide emergency response services, however, if you are receiving NDIS supports and there is an emergency or disaster that affects you, we will:

- Contact you as soon as we're aware that an emergency or disaster is affecting you and make regular contact with you
- Discuss with you the supports you need and how they can be provided
- Help you to connect with other services
- Regularly review your situation and support to suit your needs.



Key Emergency Contacts:

- In an emergency or if someone is in danger:
Call triple zero 000
- In an emergency if you have hearing or speech impairment:
Call 106 to make a text emergency call
- If you need translation or interpretation:

- If you need urgent help with poisons:
