

What will it cost?

The Australian Government provides funding for home care and support services, but you may be asked to contribute to the cost of your care. The amount you pay will be determined by your income.

If you don't wish to wait for funding approval, or are not entitled to government funding, and want to start receiving services straight away, you have the option of buying services through our self-funded service program.

This could be as a one-off service or a bundle of services. Our self-funded services are flexible and easy to arrange.
